Why it's so important for reading

When looking at near for both eyes need to move inward position for example at reading.

In this condition one or both eyes turn out when looking near.

When one or both eyes turn out this can lead to one of the three:

- Double vision at near
- 2. Suppression (using one eye and not both)
- 3. A waste of high cognitive energy in order to over come the turn.

Sign and symptoms:

- *Avoiding near tasks such as reading. Confusion at math signs and even when reading low compreation.
- *Loosing concentration very quickly. Better in the morning but finding impossible to concentrate at afternoon or evening.
- *Low attention.

Convergence insufficiency is easy to treat. It takes around 8 sessions of Orthoptic eye therapy.
